Registration Deadlines

The last day to register is July 31, 2009. If you register with a postmark or online after July 31, 2009 or register at the door, the late registration fee is \$55.00.

Meals and Banquet Tickets

The hotel requires advance numbers for noon meals and the banquet. Due to this requirement, you must register prior to July 31, 2009 to ensure your meal availability. Registrations received after this date, noon meals and the banquet meal will not be available to you.

Friday and Saturday noon meal are included with conference registration.
